Mountain View Primary school: 'a dream comes through!'

In the previous CCP update we already wrote about the plans for the construction of the first CCP Primary school. Thanks to the good cooperation with the Hans and Anneke Foundation, these plans could become reality!!

The new school is located on the grounds near the family home and the kindergarten. Work is currently underway on the roof and ceilings, followed by windows and doors and plastering. The school is not only for the most vulnerable CCP kids, but also for children from the area, who currently have no other school in the area.



Together with the Technical School, this is CCP's second 'Hans & Anneke school'.

But there's more good news. The sponsor of the family home has visited CCP in Uganda and seen with his own eyes what a blessing the house is for the emergency and crisis care of children who do not have a safe home. But the Mountain View House is packed. That is why the sponsor has given the green light for the construction of a second shelter. We hope to be able to show the photos in the next update.

Miriams Story

Miriam (pictured) was born in 2021 as the youngest in a family of four boys and two girls. Both parents were murdered in 2021 during a brutal robbery of their home. During that robbery, Miriam, who was just a baby, was also wounded in her head, hand and leg by the cruel robbers. As a result, she now goes through life as a slightly handicapped child. Miriam lives with her aunt and is now in kindergarten at school. The aunt is poor and eats just the produce of her garden. They desperately need help. (BTW. Miriam is not the real name for privacy reasons). Miriam is waiting for a sponsor!
